### First step :

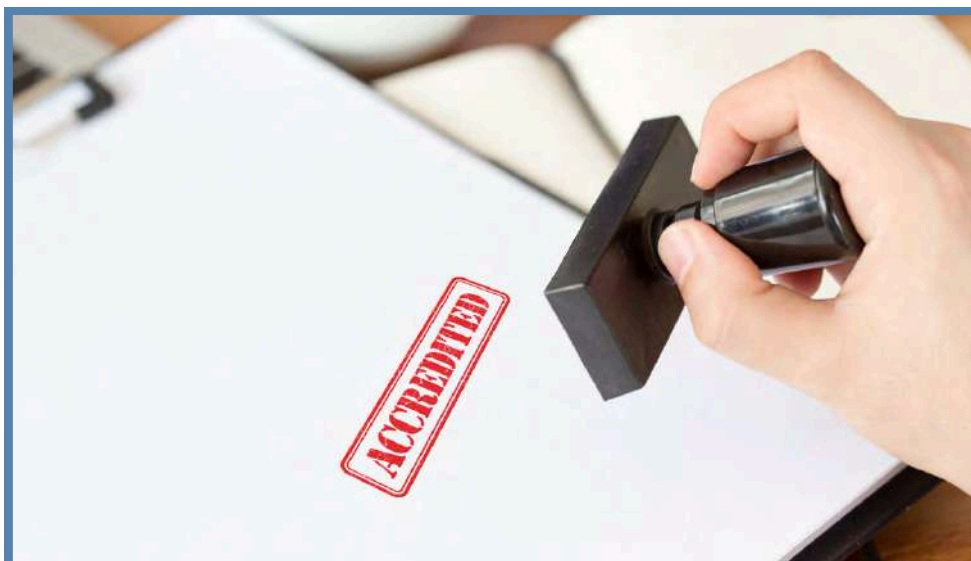
When arriving, you will be given a provisional accreditation granted you access to various designated areas.

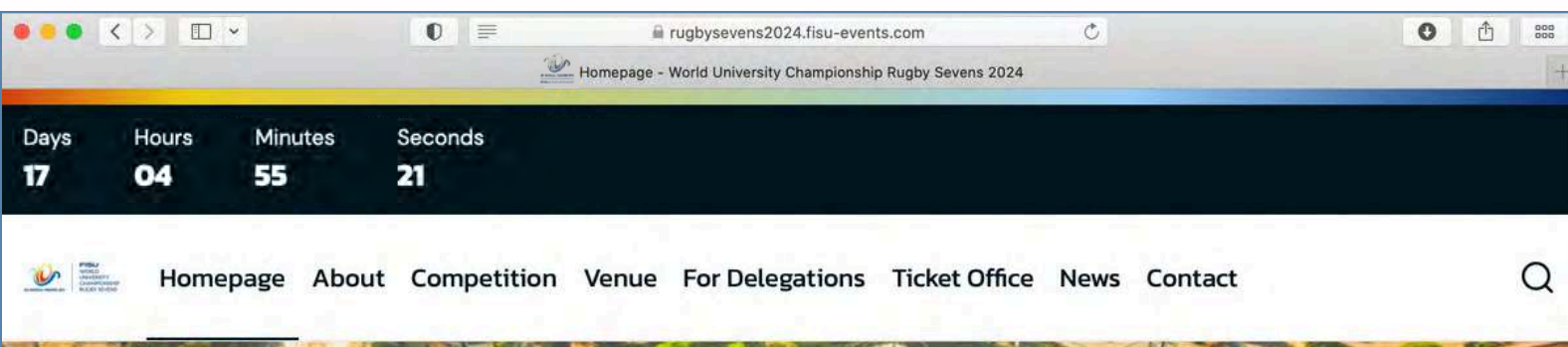
